UNIFORM CODE

Full school uniform must be worn at all times. Hair should be neat, tidy and clean.

If you are temporarily unable to wear school uniform a note must be given to Uniform Coordinator before 8:24am.

The school uniform is outlined as follows:

Uniform Expectations

- Lemon or green polo (Lemon polo being phased out end of 2025)
- Black or white long sleeve shirts may be worn under polo during cooler weather - No logos, patterns or hoodies
- School hoodie with emblem
- Green fleece zippered jacket with emblem
- School track jacket with emblem
- Green tartan skirt or culottes with emblem
- Grey knee length shorts
- Green shorts with emblem
- Grey woven long pants
- Track pants with BVC logo
- Black or white socks
- Black coloured stockings
- Black plain scarf
- Watch
- Appropriate jewellery i.e. no hooped earrings
- Fully enclosed black or white leather shoes (No coloured logo or stitching on shoes)

NB:

Leather shoes are mandatory due to Work Health & Safety Regulations. (Canvas shoes are not permitted)

Acceptable variation

A school endorsed sport current year representative jumper or jacket i.e. Sydney North, CHS, Central Coast Dance Festival or NGURA is acceptable, but they must apply for a pass from the PDHPE faculty to verify the achievement.

NB:

- Black or white socks or black coloured stockings MUST be worn
- Jeans, ¾ tights, pale grey, pinstripe or cord pants are NOT acceptable
- No tracksuit pants other than school issue or bottle green are to be worn
